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Nigerian Christian 12 Points Political (& Security) Agenda 2027

RID Nigeria enunciates this Political Agenda ahead of the 2027 General Elections, with one additional Special Interest Priority (i.e Security) to address the systemic challenges facing Christians in Nigeria.



PRESIDENTIAL EQUITABLE REPRESENTATION

Demand: The ruling and major opposition parties must end the Muslim–Muslim ticket arrangement in 2027 by fielding a credible Northern Christian as Vice Presidential candidate.

Why: Sustained exclusion of Christians at the highest executive level undermines national balance and unity.



POLITICAL PARTY LEADERSHIP REPRESENTATION

Demand: Guarantee equitable representation of Christians in the executive structures of APC, PDP, and other major parties, as well as in delegate selection processes.

Why: Christians must have a voice in candidate emergence and party policy



SECURITY & COMMUNITY PROTECTION

Demand: Establish and fund Regional Community Protection Units, recruited locally, trained professionally, accountable to states but under federal oversight, with specific mandate to safeguard churches, schools, and markets.

Why: Thousands of Christians are killed annually in preventable attacks; protection must be proactive, not reactive. Also, "Rescue the weak and the needy; deliver them from the hand of the wicked." (Psalm 82:4)



JUSTICE, ACCOUNTABILITY & RULE OF LAW

Demand: Set up Special Tribunals and Prosecutors for mass killings and religiously motivated attacks, with federal funding, victim-witness protection, and fast-track trials.

Why: Persistent impunity emboldens attackers; justice restores deterrence and dignity for victims.



Why 12 Points?

The number 12 in Scripture symbolizes government, leadership, and divine order, from the 12 tribes of Israel(Genesis 49) to the 12 apostles (Matthew 10:1–2) and the 12 gates of the New Jerusalem (Revelation 21:12-14). Presenting a 12point agenda is therefore not arbitrary but a deliberate statement: Christians in Nigeria seek a complete, orderly, and God-honoring framework for justice and governance.



PROTECTION OF RELIGIOUS FREEDOM & PLACES OF WORSHIP

Demand: Amend national security protocols to include mandatory federal protection plans for atrisk places of worship and establish a National Registry of Religious Attacks, publicly accessible and updated in real-time.

Why: Data-driven prevention and accountability are essential to safeguard freedom of worship.



INCLUSIVE REPRESENTATION IN PUBLIC APPOINTMENTS

Demand: Institute a Transparent Religious and Regional Audit of Appointments, published annually, and enforce a "Merit + Balance" principle in security, judiciary, and senior civil service roles.

Why: Visible fairness fosters trust and national cohesion.



RURAL RESILIENCE & ECONOMIC JUSTICE

Demand: Launch a National Farmer Support and Resilience Fund, climate-adaptation grants, and conflict-resolution land-use panels to reduce farmer—herder clashes and rural vulnerability. **Why:** Attacks often target rural Christian farmers; economic protection reduces both violence and displacement.




EDUCATION & YOUTH EMPOWERMENT

Demand: Expand access to federal scholarships, entrepreneurship grants, and civic education programs for Christian-majority regions, ensuring youth inclusion in governance and peacebuilding.

Why: Marginalization of Christian youths weakens national development and perpetuates cycles of poverty and extremism.





MEDIA & NARRATIVE PROTECTION

Demand: Establish a National Media Monitoring Framework for reporting religious persecution accurately, with penalties for disinformation and incentives for responsible journalism. **Why:** Silence and distortion around Christian persecution deepens trauma and global misunderstanding.

CONSTITUTIONAL & ELECTORAL REFORMS

Demand: Push for Constitutional guarantees on religious equity in executive offices and reform electoral financing laws to level the field for faith-based and minority candidates. **Why:** Without structural reforms, exclusionary politics will continue unchecked.

RESETTLEMENT, REINTEGRATION & REHABILITATION OF DISPLACED CHRISTIANS

Demand: Establish a National Christian IDP Resettlement & Reintegration Programme with three pillars:

- Resettlement & Housing: Secure land and rebuild destroyed communities, ensuring displaced Christians are restored to safe and dignified living conditions.
- Trauma Healing & Mental Health: Provide structured trauma counseling, psychosocial support, and faith-based mental health care for survivors of massacres, kidnappings, and violent displacements.
- Economic Sustainability: Introduce Christian Survivors Economic Empowerment Schemes—including
 vocational training, micro-grants, and agricultural support—to make resettled families productive and
 independent.

Why: Millions of displaced Christians in Nigeria remain in limbo, stripped of homes, livelihoods, and dignity. Without resettlement, trauma healing, and economic sustainability, their displacement becomes permanent, weakening Christian presence in vast regions.

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CHRISTIAN EDUCATION & LEADERSHIP DEVELOPMENT

Demand: Establish a National Christian Education and Leadership Fund to:

- Protect mission schools from discriminatory takeover or curriculum manipulation.
- Expand scholarships for Christian students, especially in conflict-affected regions.
- Support leadership development programs that prepare young Christians for governance, policy, and civic
 engagement.

Why: Long-term survival of the Church in Nigeria depends on an educated, confident, and strategically positioned Christian generation. Preserving Christian schools and nurturing leaders safeguards both faith and national influence

The Modernizing and Moralizing Our Political Parties (MMOP) Nigeria is a high-impact initiative of RID Nigeria under its Agenda TO35 framework. It serves as a comprehensive mentorship, mobilization, and empowerment platform for Christian youths aspiring to political leadership within the next three election cycles (2027, 2031, 2035). MMOP Nigeria combines civic engagement, spiritual mobilization, leadership development, and grassroots political participation into one unified strategy aimed at transforming Nigeria's governance culture.

Me're on a Mission to ...

Our vision is to cultivate a cadre of righteous, competent and dynamic Christian leaders who will modernize Nigeria's political parties and embed ethical governance across all levels of leadership.

The platform provides rigorous mentorship, civic education, and strategic support to ensure Christian youths not only participate in elections but win and serve with distinction.

OBJECTIVES

- Spiritual Breakthrough: To achieve 27,000 cumulative hours of prayer focused on the 2027 elections by February 2027
- Civic Engagement: To facilitate the registration of 1 million untapped christian citizens to obtain their Permanent Voter's Cards (PVCs).
- Political Integration To populate Major Political Parties by driving 1 Million christian youth to obtain Membership Card & participate actively.
- Leadership Pipeline: To provide a rigorous mentorship program for aspiring Christian political office aspirants.



THE PRAYER DRIVE


Operation 2,027 Hours of Prayer by 2027 General Election!

"I look for a man among them who would build up the wall and stand before me in the gap on behalf of the land so that I would not have to destroy it, but I found none." **Ezekiel 22:30**

Studying historic revivals across the globe reveals God's transformative work in societies. For example, The First Great Awakening in the United States during the1730s-1740s, played a role in shaping the American Revolution, encouraging moral reforms, emphasizing personal responsibility and influencing the development of democratic principles.

Similarly, the Welsh Revival in 1904-1905 brought about a spiritual awakening in Wales, leading to a positive impact of the economy, decreased alcohol consumption, reduced gambling and improved industrial relations.

Revivals have historically brought light to dark and oppressed nations, replacing the rule of principalities and powers with God's kingdom. Our prayer drive seeks to bring spiritual revolution, which will serve as the foundation for achieving the christian agenda for Nigeria.



Operation 1 Million PVCs within the christian community

The goal is to increase christian voters' participation and civic consciousness, specifically targeting first-time voters, non-voters and christian communities with low registration rates. The strategy is to demystify the PVC registration process and bring the campaign directly to our communities.

Strategic Partnerships

Engage with the Independent National Electoral Commission (INEC) to understand and streamline the registration process.

- We will partner with key christian organisations and churches to leverage their community and numbers for mass awareness and registration.
- Identify "Christian Voter Registration Hotspots" (e.g., faith-based tertiary institutions, mega churches, youth centers and conferences) and secure permits for on-site drives.

Monitoring & Follow-up

- Develop a system to track registration numbers and follow up with participants to ensure they successfully collect their PVCs.
- Create a "Christian Agenda & PVC Promise" pledge for newly registered voters to commit to casting their vote in line with our agenda in 2027.

CONTEXT & RATIONALE

Problem Statement

Christian youths in Nigeria remain largely disengaged from politics and governance, resulting in:

- Severe underrepresentation in elective and appointive positions, particularly at the grassroots level.
- Persistently low voter registration and turnout rates within Christian youth demographics.
- Minimal presence and influence within political party structures, limiting policy-shaping capacity.
- Weak mechanisms for monitoring, documenting, and influencing electoral processes from a faithbased civic engagement perspective.

This disengagement perpetuates a cycle where Christian youth voices are marginalized in decision-making arenas, undermining their ability to contribute meaningfully to governance and national development.

Youth Political landscape in Nigeria leading up to 2027

The post-End SARS era marked a turning point in Nigerian youth political consciousness. Millions of young people demonstrated the ability to organize, communicate, and mobilize at scale, primarily through digital platforms. This momentum has translated into increased voter registration and improved turnout rates in recent electoral cycles.

However, structural barriers, such as prohibitive campaign costs, limited access to political party structures, and economic hardship, continue to constrain youth from transitioning from activism to sustained political leadership.

Political disillusionment, fueled by unmet expectations and governance failures, further dampens the willingness of many to engage deeply in political processes beyond voting.

Policy and development experts increasingly call for measures to:

- Strengthen civic and political education.
- Reduce financial and procedural entry barriers for young aspirants.
- Expand mentorship and leadership pipelines for youth.
- Institutionalize youth voices in policy formulation and governance structures.

Christian Youth Political landscape

Within the Christian community, political participation has historically been hindered by a mix of theological misconceptions, the corrosive impact of political corruption, and a perception of marginalization in certain regions. This has resulted in levels of engagement that do not reflect the demographic and socio-political weight of the Christian population.

Yet, a clear shift is emerging. Faith leaders and churches are increasingly framing political participation as a moral and civic duty, an extension of Christian responsibility to seek justice, serve the common good, and uphold integrity in governance. This reframing is motivating more Christian youths to consider roles as candidates, party executives, policy advocates, and grassroots mobilizers.

WHY THE 2027 ELECTIONS MATTER FOR CHRISTIAN YOUTH REPRESENTATION

The 2027 Elections present a decisive opportunity to reshape Nigeria's governance landscape by increasing the representation and influence of Christian youth at the most immediate and impactful tier of government.

Historically, Christian youth, despite forming a significant proportion of Nigeria's population, have participated in politics primarily as voters, with minimal engagement in deeper political processes such as joining parties, attending campaign activities, or contesting for office.

Several strategic factors heighten the importance of this election cycle:



Grassroots Governance as a Launchpad for Transformation

Local governments are the governance tier closest to the people, with direct responsibility for community infrastructure, primary education, basic healthcare, and local economic development. Increased Christian youth presence in councils and chairmanship positions will ensure that governance reflects their values, priorities, and lived realities.



Shifting from Passive to Active Political Citizenship

Evidence from across Nigeria and other African contexts shows that when youth move beyond voting to contest and hold local offices, they catalyze political reforms, demand greater government accountability, and inspire broader civic participation.

For Christian youth, this transition from passive participation to active leadership is critical for long-term empowerment and societal influence.



Faith-Based Values as a Governance Asset

The Church and faith-based organizations are uniquely positioned to instil ethical leadership principles, promote non-violent political engagement, and channel youthful energy toward constructive governance roles. By embedding Christian values of justice, integrity, and service at the local level, youth leaders can counter the corrosive effects of corruption, patronage, and divisive politics.



Momentum and Mobilization Already Underway

Christian leaders, especially in Northern Nigeria, are actively mobilizing youth to participate both as voters and as candidates in 2027. This growing momentum, if matched with strategic training, mentorship, and resourcing, could mark a historic Christian leaders who will shape Nigeria's shift in Christian youth political engagement.



A Strategic Entry Point for National Influence

Local government positions often serve as entry points to state and federal political careers. The 2027 elections can therefore be leveraged as the first stage in building a sustained pipeline of governance at every level by 2035.

The 2027 OPPORTUNITY WINDOW

The next electoral cycle offers a unique convergence of factors:

An energized youth population with demonstrated capacity for mass mobilization.

02

A growing movement within Christian communities to overcome political apathy.

03

Rising demand for ethical, competent, and valuesdriven leadership across all levels of governance.

Local Government Elections, State Houses of Assembly contests, and intra-party executive roles in 2027 will serve as critical entry points for Christian youth into Nigeria's broader political architecture. These positions, though often overlooked, shape budget priorities, influence development outcomes, and serve as launchpads for higher office.

Mobilization and Digital Influence

Christian youths, alongside the broader youth cohort, demonstrated impressive mobilization in 2023, especially through social media and civic campaigns. 02

Underrepresentation Despite Engagement

Youth candidacy and electoral wins increased marginally but remain far below population share, especially among Christian youths.

03

Ethical Complexity in Faith-Based Politics

Political endorsements by Christian leaders invite both opportunity and scrutiny, balancing moral motivation against risks of sectarian mobilization.

STRATEGIC OPPORTUNITY AT THE LOCAL GOVERNMENT LEVEL



The Local Government (LG) tier represents the closest point of governance to the grassroots and offers a strategic entry point for Christian youth participation in Nigeria's political landscape. Unlike national and state politics, LG structures are more accessible, less resource-intensive, and allow for direct engagement with community needs.

Many LG councils across the country operate with limited political competition, particularly in rural and semi-urban areas, creating a window for committed and organized Christian youth to win elective positions or secure influential party executive roles. By securing ward and LG-level party offices, Christian youths can influence candidate selection, policy priorities, and resource allocation at the most immediate level of governance.

Additionally, controlling political influence at the LG level builds a strong leadership pipeline. It provides practical governance experience, enhances visibility, and creates a base from which future state and national leadership can emerge. With Nigeria's governance structure placing significant administrative and developmental responsibilities in the hands of LG councils, this level offers Christian youths the opportunity to implement values-driven leadership that directly impacts infrastructure, education, health, and social welfare in their communities.

Focusing strategically on LG politics not only decentralizes Christian political influence but also ensures a sustainable, grassroots-to-national growth model for political inclusion and governance transformation.

WHY USE THE TWO MAJOR POLITICAL PARTIES IS A STRATEGIC CHOICE

Using the two major political parties (PDP and APC) as a strategic choice is grounded in political reality, influence pathways, and res



Access to the largest political platforms

The two dominant parties in Nigeria command the broadest national reach, party structures, and grassroots machinery. Operating within them provides immediate access to existing networks, mobilization channels, and established political capital, without the long and costly process of building a new party.



Higher probability of electoral success

In Nigeria's current political landscape, smaller parties face severe limitations in winning major elections. Aligning with the two biggest parties allows Christian youths to compete for positions where electoral victories are realistically attainable.



Influence from within

It's easier to shape policy and decisions from inside a dominant party's power structure than to influence it from outside. By holding internal party offices, Christian youths can impact candidate selection, agenda setting, and party manifestos at the ward, local government, state, and even national levels.



Concentration of resources for maximum impact

Rather than spreading efforts across many small parties, working within the two biggest parties focuses human, financial, and mobilization resources on platforms with the highest return on investment in terms of visibility, influence, and election wins.



Strategic positioning for long-term leadership

Building credibility, track records, and networks inside major parties creates a pipeline for Christian youth leaders to rise to higher offices over successive election cycles. governorships, National Assembly seats, and eventually presidential influence.


